POLICY OF ADMISSION AND RETENTION (Effective SY 2018-2019)

- 1. Admission in the Bachelor of Arts in Communication program under the Department of Languages, Mass Communication and Humanities of Central Philippine University is only upon the advice and consent of the Chair of the Department.
 - a. S/he should exhibit competence in oral and written English by getting: (1)
 80 or higher in the College Academic English Placement Test
 (2) 85 or higher in the entrance essay test
 - (3) 70 or higher in the entrance oral test
 - b. A shiftee enrolled in another degree program prior to SY 2018-2019, should have earned a grade of at least 2.0 in English 1a, English 2a and Speech 1 and must get a rating of 85 or higher in the entrance essay test and 70 or higher in the entrance oral test.
 - c. A shiftee enrolled in another degree program starting SY 2018-2019 should have earned a grade of at least 2.0 in Purposive Communication and must get a rating of 85 or higher in the entrance essay test and 70 or higher in the entrance oral test. If s/he has not taken Purposive Communication yet, section 1 a shall be used as basis for evaluation.
- 2. <u>When accepted</u>, the BA Comm major must complete the three prerequisite Communication courses with grades no lower than 2.5 in order to continue. Moreover, s/he must get a grade of at least 2.5 in the rest of the major subjects.
- If the student incurs a grade of <u>5.0</u> in a major subject, s/he is given one more chance to retake the subject, but s/he must meet the grade requirement of <u>2.5 or</u> <u>better</u>. Subsequent failure in any other major subject means disqualification from the program.
- 4. The same retention and admission policies will apply to shiftees and transferees.
